



The Sally Munson Scholarship Fund Guidelines

The Sally Munson Scholarship Fund (SMSF) was established in 1983 to honor the late Sally Munson, who was a past leader of the Community of Presbyterian Women at North Presbyterian Church (NPC), a past Moderator of the Presbytery of Western New York, and a devoted elder and churchwoman.

The purpose of the SMSF is to encourage participation in the wider church by financially aiding members of NPC in being able to attend denominational meetings, conventions, and workshops.

Income to the SMSF is derived from bequests to the Memorial Fund of NPC specifically designated for the SMSF, as well as from gifts from members made through the Community of Presbyterian Women at NPC, and from other fundraising events and activities.

Recipients and the amount of money awarded shall be determined by the Coordinating Team of the Community of Presbyterian Women at NPC. Eligible recipients shall:

1. Be active/confirmed members of NPC,
2. Submit a completed application to a circle leader or to the Treasurer or President of the Coordinating Team of the Community of Presbyterian Women at NPC,
3. Provide a brief written report to the Coordinating Team, sharing the benefits of the event and a short evaluation of the program, and
4. If asked, will personally relate their experiences at a circle meeting or other appropriate gathering at NPC.
